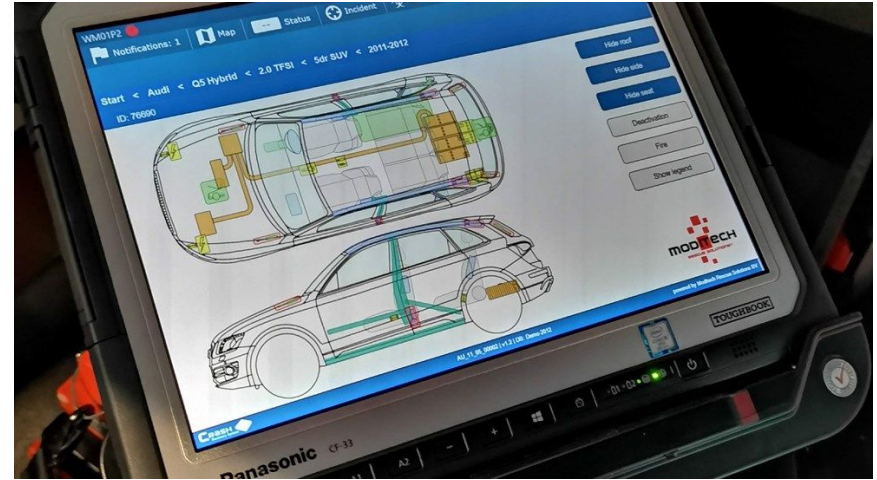

Introduction








This aims to provide guidance the use of a Fix Appliance MDT (Mobile Data Terminal).

The Fix Appliance MDT is fitted to allow the front passenger of an appliance to use it with relative ease.

The MDT may be accessed using the Pump and water pressure display at the rear of an appliance in the event that is a more suitable place.

Radio Etiquette

When joining the LFB Frequency we have a structure to how your name should be laid out, the reason for this is to make it easier for command members to identify certain people.

Collar Number [xxxx]	Vehicle Callsign [callsign]	Character Name Name
-------------------------	--------------------------------	------------------------

[1234] [BM1] P.Smith

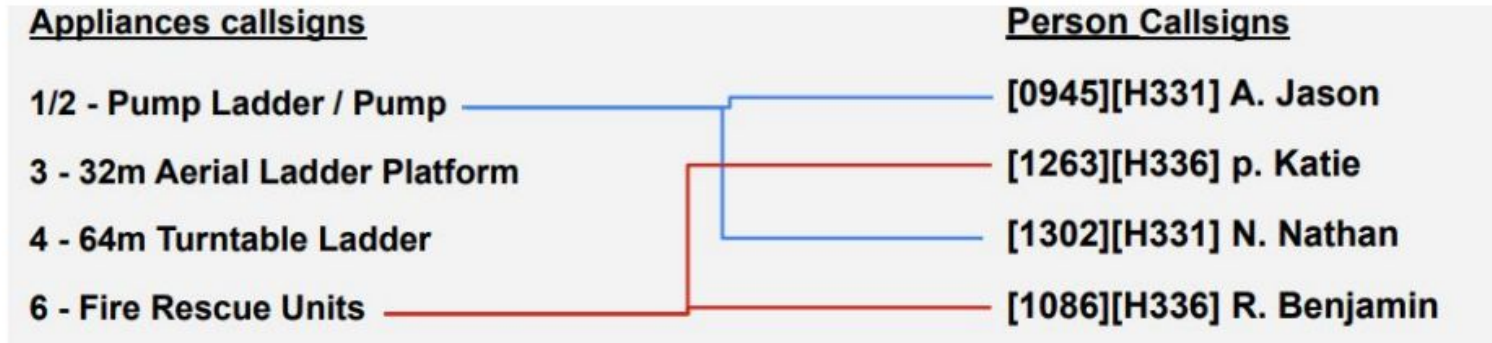
[1332] [E391] I.Jane

Vehicle Assignments

When starting your shift if command is on you may be assigned to an appliance.



Radio Transmission

When speaking over radio you must be cautious in case EOC is online, if so then you must use proper radio etiquette to speak to the controller.

“Control from HOTEL 331 over” as they will reply with “HOTEL 331 from Control go ahead over”.

All communications via the radio must be for a professional purpose. At no time should you have a general conversation over the frequency.
